SCHOOL COMMITTEE POLICY

Policy #12

School Admissions

Students shall be admitted to the Medway Public Schools who are:

1. Legal residents of the district.
2. Residing in the district with a legally appointed guardian who is a resident of the district.
3. Wards of the state or court and are living within the district.
4. Homeless and are temporarily residing within the district.
5. Living within the district with a parent/guardian who is a resident of the district.
6. Residents of a district that has contracted with the Medway Public Schools for the student's education services.
7. Approved for school choice.
8. Participating in an approved foreign exchange program and being housed in the district.

No person shall be excluded from or discriminated against in admission to a public school in Medway, or in obtaining the advantages, privileges and courses of study of such public school on account or race, color, sex, religion, national origin or sexual orientation.
