# Background

When well developed, Student Management Systems support:

- administrative tasks
- online registration
- complex student scheduling
- online grading
- attendance
- robust analytics, reporting, alerts, and differentiated instruction plans
- parent / student communications
- state reporting
- medical documentation and record keeping
- specific student plans (IEPs, 504s, health plans, etc.)

# Rationale for Exploration of New System

- MMS/Vision has been in use by the district for over thirty years.
- MMS/Vision is less intuitive, less user friendly, and inefficient for administrative tasks, scheduling, and communications.
- Recent Update by MMS to Visions has further impacted user experience and efficiency
- Supplemental products are currently needed to support:
  - real-time reports and data driven decisions
  - efficient workflows and access to data
  - time spent on administrative tasks and data management
  - effective and efficient communications to our community via email, portals, and online resources

# Our Exploration Process

- Established a robust feature list through collaboration with leadership team
- Outreach to other districts who have facilitated recent explorations
- Connections with multiple vendors on the state bid list
- Conducted multiple vendor presentations with diverse user groups (secretaries, central office, district and school leaders, curriculum and instruction leaders, information services personnel)
- Collected and collated system feedback in comparison to identified priorities

# *Infinite Campus*: Program Highlights

Infinite Campus stood out as a premium product to our users based on the following:

- easy to navigate and access data (grades, demographics, analytics)
- one location to manage data
- centralized platform for all general education, special education, health information, and student alerts
- intuitive and easily navigable Parent / Student Portal
- accessibility from any device and screen size
- integration with Google, Office365, and other resources for ease of use, content development
- analytics and tools for academic intervention
- integrated online registration and student demographic information
- sophisticated reporting system to support data driven decisions.

# *Infinite Campus*: Proposed Implementation Timeline

Dates (estimated)	Description
Early February, 2019	Kick Off Meetings, Implementation Team Development, Setup/Prep
Mid-February - early July, 2019	Three phase data conversion and validation processes, converting last six years of data
February - September, 2019	Training sessions for varied user groups at logical intervals
End of July 2019	Final setup and Go Live!
Winter, 2019-2020	Utilize <i>Infinite Campus</i> Schedule Builder for the 2021-2022 school year

# *Infinite Campus*: Implementation Costs

Element	Cost	Cost Type
On-boarding	\$60,000 (includes all training modules)	One time
Overlap of current products during transition	\$10,000-\$15,000	One time
Annual	\$25,000	Annual
Premium Modules	\$7500- \$15,000	Annually (Online Registration, Voice Messaging, Secure Check-In)
